



Credo Reference Collection

Credo Reference provides access to 100 online full-text reference books (dictionaries, encyclopedias, etc.) in many different subject areas. You can search by keyword or browse by topic categories. You can search all books at once, within a category, or within a book.

1. Access **Credo Reference** from the GALILEO home page (www.galileo.usg.edu):

- * Remote online students must type the current GALILEO Password in the login textbox on the GALILEO home page and click “Login” prior to Step A.
- A. Click on the yellow “Databases A-Z” button, then type **Credo Reference** in the text box and click on the “Find Database” button.

(or click “C” from the alphabetic index above the text box).
- B. Click on the **Credo Reference** link.

2. **Searching Credo Reference:**

- A. Enter your search terms in the “Search” textbox and click on “Search.” The default is to search all books, but you can use the subject links or links to individual books to limit your search results to make them more relevant, if needed.
- B. A result list will be displayed that includes the relevant search terms in context and the book in which they were found.

3. **Viewing Search Results:**

- A. Locate the item you want to view from the “Search Results” list and click on the underlined term just above that entry. The entire entry that contains your search terms will display.
- B. A sample citation to the book will display below the entry. You can choose from several of the most used citation formats, including MLA and APA styles.
