



## **Finding Scholarly Articles using Literary Reference Center**

1. Start at the **GALILEO Scholar** home page: **www.galileo.usg.edu**.
2. Click on the yellow "**Databases A-Z**" button.
3. Type "**Literary Reference Center**" in the text box and click on "Find Database" (or click the "L" index and select from an alphabetic list).
4. Click on the "**Literary Reference Center**" link to open the search screen.
5. Type your search terms in the "**Find**" text box near the top of the screen.
6. **Search results are listed in blocks of ten brief article citations.**

The title of the article appears in blue and is underlined, followed by the author, publication, date, volume, issue number and pages.

7. **To view the full-text article:** click on the links beneath the title labeled: HTML Full Text or PDF Full Text .
8. **To print the article:** For HTML Full-Text articles use the printer icon on the web browser toolbar above the text OR the print icon at the top of the article; for PDF Full-Text articles select the printer icon on the Adobe toolbar.
9. To return to the list of results, click the "**Result List**" link above the text of the article.
10. **Revising Literary Reference Center Search Selections**

The LRC Result List defaults to the "All Results" tab. To view items by specific document type, click on one of the corresponding tabs across the top such as "**Biographies,**" "**Literary Criticism,**" "**Plot Summaries,**" etc.

Depending on your search terms and results displayed, the LRC Result List may also offer a "Narrow Results by" window to the left of your returned items that allows you to limit by "**Subject**" or "**Publication.**" Selecting either of these options will provide with further drop down choices to narrow your search.
