Registration Fee	\$75 per year
Preschool* (2.5yrs to Pre-K eligible; 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM)	\$130 per week
Georgia Pre-K** (8:00 AM to 2:30 PM)	Lottery Funded
Pre-K Extended Care (6:30 AM to 8:00 AM; 2:30 PM to 6:00 PM)	\$65 per week
In-service Care (Ages 2.5-8 years) (when Pre-K is closed; Reservations Required)	\$26 per day
Late Payment Fee	\$10 per week
Late Pickup Fee	\$10 per 15 minutes late

*Preschool students **MUST** be 2.5 years old by the time of enrollment and can participate in the program at anytime during the year.

Georgia Pre-K students **MUST be 4 years old by **September 1st** of the school year.

ACTIVITY REQUIREMENTS
