Approximate Cost Expectations

After selection, Radiologic Technology students *should* expect four semesters of full-time instruction. The hours may vary from 6:45 a.m. — 5:00 p.m. and are typically 8:30 am to 4:00 pm each for didactic courses and 6:45am to 5:30 pm each clinical day as well as a two-week evening rotation (12:00p-9:00p). Other expected expenses (not including tuition) are:

Textbooks: ~\$900

- first semester = approx. \$600
- remaining semesters = approx. \$300 more for the remaining semesters

BLS CPR certification: American Heart Association (approximately \$8 at CGTC)

BLS provider book and pocket mask: approximately \$50 - \$75

Physical Examination: approx. \$60-100.00 (your physician)

Immunizations: approx. \$50-\$300

- TB (2-step)
- Flu (REQUIRED)
- Immunization records may need to be updated; list will be given in orientation

Respirator Fit Test: approx. \$20

10 Panel Drug Screen & Background Check (Verified Credentials AND Pre-Check): all must be completed prior to 1st semester and again annually

- Verified- approx. \$170
- Pre-Check- approx. \$100
- HCA myClinicalExchange- approx. \$60

<u>Liability Insurance:</u> included in RADT 1320 tuition (1st Semester)- approx. \$15

<u>Uniforms/Scrub Jacket:</u> approximately \$50-75 per set; 3 required during 1st Semester (most students purchase 3-4 over their clinical experience). There may be additional uniform requirements based on campus the student is attending

Professional Shoes: (All White or All Black solid leather) \$50-100.00

Required Supplies for Clinical: approx. \$150 during 1st Sem. This includes but is not limited to:

- personalized markers (\$25-\$30)
- personal dosimeter/radiation monitoring device each semester (\$45 included in tuition)
- lost dosimeter fee (\$120)

Additional expenses:

- ASRT- Professional society membership: \$35-50.00
- Travel expenses to and from each clinical setting
- Graduation application fees \$40.00
- Expenses after Graduation Required to Apply for Credentialing by ARRT: ARRT Registry Fee: \$200 — upon graduation

Costs above may vary, and students will be given detailed information about requirements in program orientation, but the intent is to give the prospective student an idea of the financial obligations that the Radiologic Technology student will incur. Financial Aid may assist with these costs, but may not cover all of the costs of the program and supplies. The above expense list does not include costs for housing, food, and mileage to travel to and from campus and clinical sites.

CGTC's RADT program is supported by area hospitals, orthopedic facilities and urgent care centers which serve as clinical sites for the program. In order to obtain the required clinical practice for each course, the student is required to meet certain employment criteria for these clinical sites including, but not limited to, health clearance through physical examination, negative drug/alcohol screening, and negative criminal background history. The clinical sites (independent of the CGTC-MACON RADT program) determine those students who meet their criteria for clinical practice.
