The Cardiovascular Technology degree program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on March 31, 2015.

The program will publish a 3 year review window average results of the outcomes for national credentialing exam pass rate, retention, and positive placement of the accredited program.

2018 Results:

Retention: 10 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology Program. As of Fall Semester 2018 (201912) 70% (7 of 10) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 60% (3 out of 5) students of the 2017 enrollment class attempted Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination 66% (2 out of 3) passed.

Positive Placement: 100% (5 out of 5) students of the 2017 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.

2017 Result:

Retention: 7 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology Program. One student was readmitted from previous year, for a total class size of 8 students. As of Fall Semester 2017 (201812) 75% (6 of 8) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 60% (3 out of 5) students of the 2016 enrollment class attempted Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination 66% (2 out of 3) passed.

Positive Placement: 100% (5 out of 5) students of the 2016 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.

2016 Results:

Retention: 10 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology program. As of Fall Semester 2016 (201714) 50% (5 of 10) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 100% (3 out of 3) students of the 2015 enrollment class, attempted Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination 33% (1 out of 3) passed.

Positive Placement: 100% (3 out of 3) students of the 2015 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.
