Feedback from the students who have taken the RCIS said that it was heavy on vascular which they said they did not review much. Students also have not been reporting back to the program chair whether they have passed the exams or not in order to get accurate results for the annual report.

CCI RCIS Action Plan

The program chair has been in contact with individuals from Cardiovascular Credentialing International concerning the pass results and have received data from the past two years of students who say they attended CGTC RCIS results. The program is planning on turning the Registry review class back into an online class due to in the past students had higher pass rates with having the class online versus in person. This will not happen until the Spring 2024 semester. This was also discussed in the advisory committee meeting held on November 14th, 2023.
