



Paramedic Program

The Paramedic program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on 23 March 2015.

In accordance with CAAHEP Standard V.A.4., The program will publish, preferably in a readily accessible place on their websites, the 3-year review-window average results of the outcomes for: National Registry (or State, as applicable) Written and Practical Exams, Retention, and Positive Placement.

All paramedic classes graduate in December.

Pre-Accreditation 3 year review window average results for 2017, 2016, and 2015:

National Registry examination: 3 year average – 74% (25 out of 34)

2017: 6 out of 9 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (66%)

2016: 13 out of 15 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (86%)

2015: 6 out of 10 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (60%)

Retention: 3 year average – 74% (37 out of 50)

2017: 17 students registered. 11 completed the program for a retention rate of 65%

2016: 17 Students registered. 16 completed the program for a retention rate of 94%

2015: 16 Students registered. 10 completed the program for a retention rate of 63%

Positive Placement: 3 year average – 100% (44 out of 44)

2017: All students were employed in the field. (11 out of 11)

2016: All students were employed in the field. (16 out of 16)

2015: All students were employed in the field. (10 out of 10)
