Course Articulation Agreement

**Associate of Science in Early Childhood Care & Education to Bachelor of
Science in Education with a concentration in Early Childhood Special
Education**

1. The two institutions are entering into a Course Articulation Agreement to assist in and promote the transferability in Early Childhood programs between the two institutions.
2. The joint program will be open to Central Georgia Technical College (CGTC) graduates with any approved associates degree in Early Childhood Care & Education and only for candidates entering the Bachelor of Science in Education with a concentration in Early Childhood Special Education degree at Middle Georgia State University (MGA).
3. All CGTC courses transferred to MGA's general core (Areas A through F) OR to major requirements at MGA will be taught by qualified faculty with a minimum of a Master's degree and 18 graduate hours in the field.
4. General Education Courses: Middle Georgia State University accepts the general education courses for transfer as detailed in the articulation agreement between the University System of Georgia and Technical College System of Georgia. Courses will only be accepted from institutions accredited by the Commission of Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
5. Qualified CGTC graduates may receive transfer credit for CGTC courses to be applied toward MGA's School of Education & Behavioral Sciences, Department of Teacher Education & Social Work Area F for a maximum 9 hours, i.e., up to 3 courses. This list may be amended by written agreement of the Deans of the schools at each college.

7. Admission to the Department of Teacher Education & Social Work:

In order to be admitted to the Early Childhood Special Education Baccalaureate program at MGA under this agreement, the student must meet the following requirement:


Document eligibility for admission to Middle Georgia State University under current admission requirements outlined in the University Catalog.

A student transferring into the baccalaureate program may graduate under the provisions of the Middle Georgia State University Catalog and requirements which were in effect when the student was accepted into the four-year program.

8. All MGA candidates for degree must complete a minimum of 120 semester hours of academic work with a grade point of 2.75 or better. The academic work must include 60 semester hours of upper level education courses.
9. All University System of Georgia and MGA requirements for graduation must be satisfied.
10. This agreement is effective for students who graduate with a degree from CGTC beginning July 1, 2013.
