



Memorandum of Understanding

between
York St John University (YSJU) and
Central Georgia Technical College (CGTC)

1. In order to promote international education and understanding, YSJU, and CGTC agree to explore future co-operation and collaboration. The aim of shared and joint activity is to maximise opportunities for students and staff while being able to demonstrate shared commitment throughout to recognised standards of quality assurance.
2. YSJU and CGTC expect, in due course, to be able to produce a co-operation agreement laying out specific details of collaboration. Patterns of collaboration may include, among others:
 - progression of students to YSJU's final year undergraduate programmes and Masters-level programmes
 - development of exchange and summer programmes
 - exchange and/or mobility of students and teaching and research staff
 - discussion of additional collaborative models
 - joint research projects
3. Following the signing of this Memorandum of Understanding, documentation will be exchanged and plans made for future co-operation. Relevant committees and senior management within the two institutions will be kept fully informed at each stage once the specific forms of collaboration have been agreed.
