2.4.1.a.p_(formerly I.D.1.a) Central Georgia Technical College Responsibilities and Authority



The State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia is the legally constituted governing board of the Central Georgia Technical College.

The State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia has, by authority of State law O.C.G.A. 20-4-11, established the Board of Directors of Central Georgia Technical College and has delegated certain authority and responsibility to the local board.

The Local Board of Directors for the consolidated Central Georgia Technical College was established in July 2013. The Board's members are representative of the College's eleven county service area. The members are appointed by the State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia.

The Board's role is to provide advice to the President of CGTC on the needs of the citizenry, business, and industry in the College's service area and advocates for the State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia on issues of importance in support of technical education and workforce development.

The Local Board of Directors meets a minimum of eight times each year. Regular meetings are held on the third Tuesday of the month at an agreed upon time set by the Board's chairperson. The President is not a member of the Local Board.
