Academic Success Center

Provides individual and group tutoring, academic and study skills workshops, assistance with student technology, program placement test guidance, and more. Academic Success Center services are offered at no charge.

Admissions

Processes applications for new students, assists with program changes, manages the competitive selection process for health sciences programs, handles changes in student information and program changes, and works with students to ensure that all application steps have been completed.

Barbering Services

Provides services such as cuts, styles, shaves, and relaxers. All work is performed by CGTC students.

Bookstore

Location where students can purchase textbooks, school supplies, program supplies, CGTC apparel, snacks, and more.

Campus Police/Security

Provides security and safety services, maintains lost-and-found, and more.

CARE Center

Advises new students and helps students sign up for classes; provides resources and guides for all students; helps students with technology such as BannerWeb, Blackboard, and the Student Portal; and directs students to other resources, such as Special Populations and Career Services, as needed.

Career Services

Offers career counseling, resume and job search assistance, online job database, career fairs, and more.

Cashier

Location where students can make a payment for expenses such as tuition and fees and parking tickets.

Computers for Student Use

Locations where students can use computers and printers.

Cosmetology Services

Provides services such as hair color, perms, cuts, styles, relaxers, manicures, pedicures, facials, and hair removal. All work is performed by CGTC students.

Counseling Resource Center

Offers confidential assistance with issues such as anxiety, stress, emotional problems, relationships, and alcohol/substance abuse. Additional services may include: coping skills, crisis management, anger management, support groups, and community referrals. Services are provided by a non-judgmental, licensed professional.

Dental Hygiene Clinic

Provides dental hygiene services such as screenings, radiographs, teeth whitening, fluoride treatments, and more. All work is performed by CGTC students.

Distance Education/Online Classes

Provides technical support for online classes. Please contact your instructor first.

Financial Aid

Coordinates financial aid programs, including the federal PELL Grant, HOPE Scholarship and Grant, veteran's benefits, Federal Direct Loans, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG), Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), and the HOPE Career Grant.

Foundation

Provides scholarships to assist students with tuition and fees, textbooks, program supplies, and more (some restrictions apply).

IT Helpdesk/Technology

Provides login support for classroom and lab computers, student email, Student Portal, and Microsoft Office 365.

Library Services

Locations for students to access computers, books, magazines, videos, and online learning resources, and to make copies. CGTC students can also borrow materials and use library resources at Fort Valley State University, Georgia College and State University, Middle Georgia State University, and any of Georgia's technical colleges.

Military and Veterans Financial Aid

Works specifically with military-affiliated students for VA benefits and other types of financial aid.

Military and Veterans Services

Offers academic advising, transitional guidance, and opportunities for students to connect with other military-affiliated students.

Registrar

Handles withdrawals and enrollment verifications. Reviews transcripts for transfer credit. Processes graduation applications and transient applications.

Special Populations/Disability Services

Provides resources for students who are single parents, economically disadvantaged, displaced homemakers, dislocated workers, special needs, and/or enrolled in non-traditional programs. Offers testing accommodations, alternative textbook formats, assistive technology, and more to qualified students with disabilities.

Testing Center

Administers placement tests, the ACT WorkKeys® assessment, the PSB Health Occupations Aptitude Exam, the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS), pest control exams, CLEP exam, and more.

Titans Café

Location to purchase hot food, sandwiches, salads, snacks, and beverages. Students can call ahead to place an order.

Vending Machines/Student Lounge

Locations to purchase snacks and cold beverages.

Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)

A federally-funded program that provides training and assistance with tuition and fees, textbooks and required supplies, uniforms and tools to economically disadvantaged and dislocated workers. Additional support services are available based on individual eligibility and WIOA policy.
