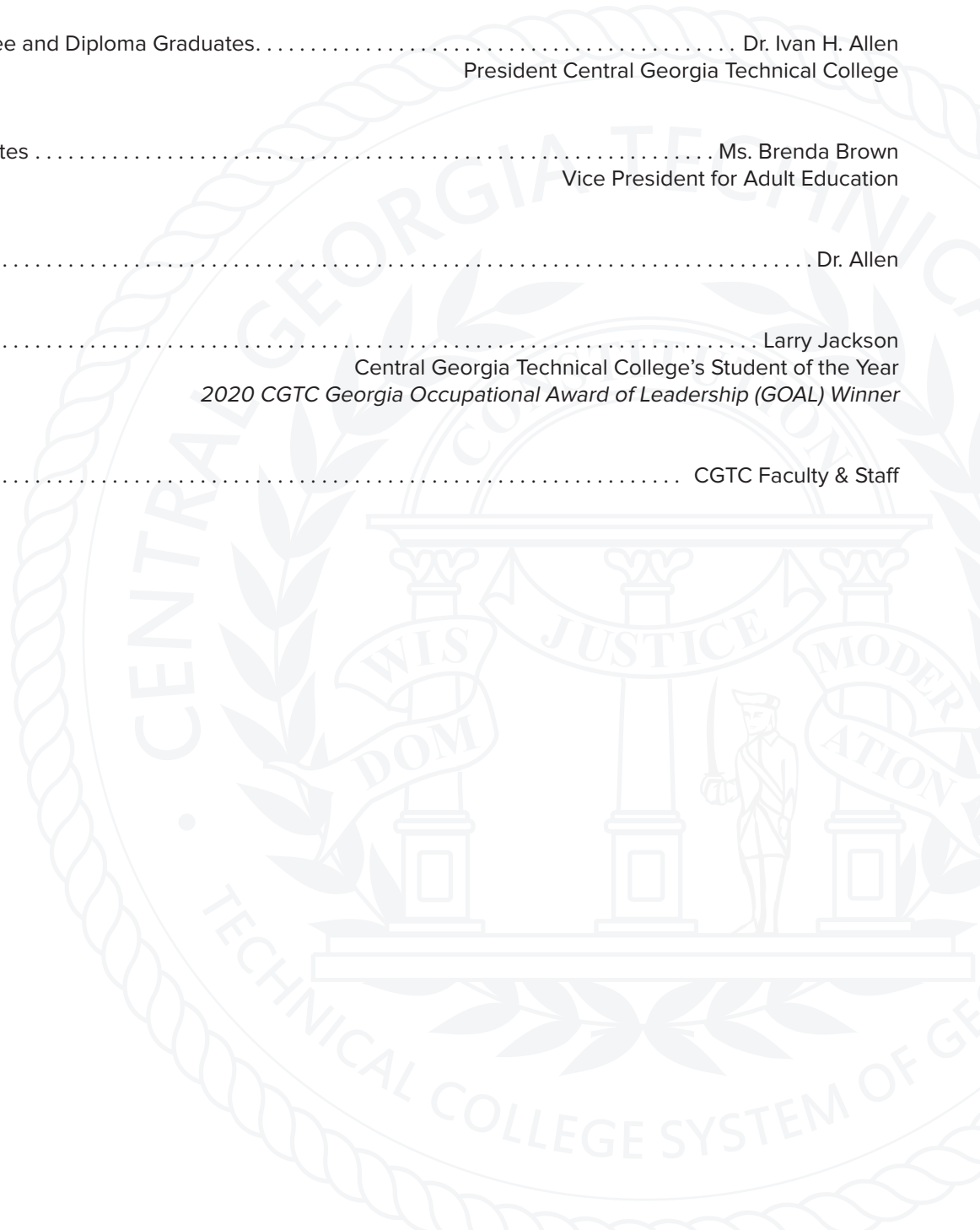
## **COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY DECORUM**

## SPECIAL RECOGNITION



### **LARRY JACKSON**

#### *2020 CGTC Georgia Occupational Award of Leadership Winner*

Central Georgia Technical College (CGTC) designated Larry Jackson, a student in the Clinical Laboratory Technology program, as the winner of the Georgia Occupational Award for Leadership (GOAL) in Spring 2020. Chosen by two panels of judges from the College and community, Jackson represents his peers and the Technical College System of Georgia, advocating locally and across the state for technical education.

In 2016, Jackson re-entered society following incarceration. While incarcerated, he was part of a pilot Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) program ran by the former Middle Georgia Technical College (MGTC) in the prison system in 2005 before its merger with CGTC in 2013. Following his release, he has worked diligently to complete his education and career goals, while positioning himself as an example of personal fortitude and strength.

Program chair for CGTC's Clinical Laboratory Technology program, and Larry's nominating instructor for GOAL, LaShauna Hunt, said this award "appropriately reflects his hard work and dedication to learning."

In 2018, he began working as a lab assistant in the Health Sciences program. Today, he graduates with an Associate's Degree in Clinical Laboratory Technology.



### **JESSICA WILLCOX**

#### *2020 CGTC Rick Perkins Award Winner*

The College's 2020 Rick Perkins Award for Excellence (RPA) winner and director of Nursing Program, Jessica Willcox, has had a substantial beginning to her technical education story. Upon her fulltime arrival at the College in 2014, Willcox was tasked with developing the Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program, Registered Nursing (RN) program, and was responsible for leading the Division of Nursing faculty to see the program through to initial accreditation.

Willcox believes technical education is set to become the public's first-choice in the future, as she has helped usher several cohorts of nurses into the nation's healthcare systems.

Faculty nominated Willcox for the honor and she was selected by a community panel to represent the College. She is thankful for the opportunity to represent the College.

Willcox, originally from Tifton, Ga., celebrated her tenth wedding anniversary this past May and has two daughters, two dogs, and a pet pig.



### **EMANUEL CLARK**

#### *2020 CGTC Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy Education Delegate*

As the Adult Education Division's 2020 Exceptional Adult Georgian in Literacy Education (EAGLE) delegate, Emanuel Clark has the distinct position to show how the College's mission to educate adult students impacts and improves the local community.

"I understand that our local and state economy, and my own life benefits from the Division's commitment to students without a GED," Clark said.

Nominated by an instructor, Clark is a spokesperson for the work of Adult Education, just a year removed from earning his GED in 2019.

After several attempts to complete the program, serving time in prison, he came to the realization that education is paramount. He is committed to sharing what the GED program has done for him with all who will listen.

EAGLE is the first statewide program in the nation that recognizes and rewards excellence among students enrolled in adult education programs. This student recognition program is designed to create greater awareness of educational opportunities that are available in local communities across the state and to foster greater involvement in lifelong learning pursuits.

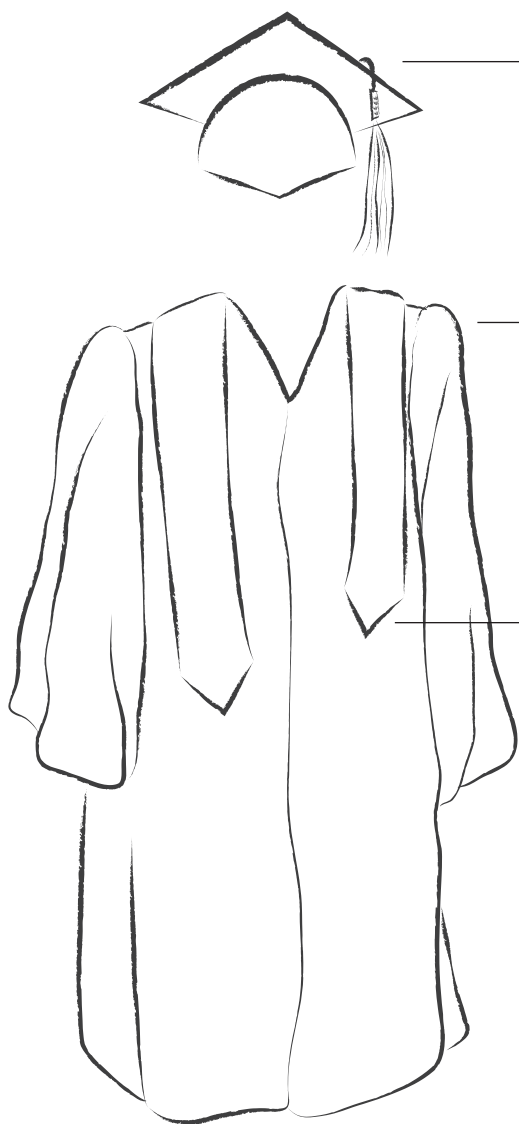
# THE MEANING OF ACADEMIC DRESS

The origins of academic dress date back to the 12th and 13th centuries, when universities were taking form. The ordinary dress of the scholar was that of a cleric, whether the scholar was a student or teacher. Long gowns were worn and may have been necessary for warmth in unheated buildings. Hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until superseded for that purpose by the skull cap.

A statute of the University of Coimbra in 1321 required that all “Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors” wear gowns. In England, in the second half of the 14th century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade “excess in apparel” and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. In the days of Henry VIII of England, Oxford and Cambridge first began prescribing a definite academic dress and made it a matter of university control. The assignment of colors to signify certain faculties was to be a much later development, and one which was to be standardized only in the United States in the late 19th century.

In America, an Intercollegiate Commission made up of representatives of leading institutions was formed to establish a standardized system of academic apparel. The Commission met at Columbia University in 1895 and adopted a code of academic dress that regulated the cut and style and materials of the gowns and prescribed the colors which were to represent the different fields of learning. In 1932, a committee appointed by the American Council on Education approved a code for academic costumes that has been in effect since that year. The American Council on Education revised and updated the code in 1959 and 1986.

## Cap

Mortarboards are generally recommended to match the gown. A long tassel is to be fastened to the middle point of the top of the cap only and allowed to lie as it will. The tassel should be the same color as the cap, or the color appropriate to the subject. All graduates should wear the tassel on the right side of their caps.

## Gown

The color of the gown varies by credential as follows:

Maroon:	Degree Graduate
Navy:	Diploma Graduate
Gray:	GED® Graduate

## Cords and Stoles

Honor graduates wear a gold cord. To receive this honor, graduates must have a graduation GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Members of the National Technical Honor Society wear a white tassel on their caps and a white stole. To receive this honor, students must be nominated by an instructor, be a full-time student at CGTC for at least two complete semesters, and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5.

Members of the Military and Veterans wear a red, white, and blue cord.

High School Dual Enrollment students wear a teal cord.
