Central Georgia Technical College

The Cardiovascular Technology degree program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on March 31, 2015.

The program will publish a 3 year review window average results of the outcomes for national credentialing exam pass rate, retention, and positive placement of the accredited program.

2019 Results:

Retention: 10 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology Program. As of Fall Semester 2019 (202012) 100% (10 of 10) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 71% (5 out of 7) students of the 2018 enrollment class attempted the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination. 40% (2 of 5) successfully passed the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on first attempt. 60% (3 of 5) did not pass Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on first attempt.

Positive Placement: 86% (6 out of 7) students of the 2018 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.

2018 Results:

Retention: 10 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology Program. As of Fall Semester 2018 (201912) 70% (7 of 10) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 80% (4 of 5) students of the 2017 enrollment class attempted the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination. 75% (3 of 4) successfully passed the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on first attempt. 25% (1 of 4) did not pass Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on first attempt.

Positive Placement: 100% (5 out of 5) students of the 2017 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.

2017 Result:

Retention: 6 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology Program. One student was readmitted from previous year, for a total class size of 7 students. As of Fall Semester 2017 (201812) 85% (6 of 7) of students were retained.

Credentialing exam pass rate: 80% (4 of 5) students of the 2016 enrollment class attempted the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination. 75% (3 of 4) successfully passed the Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on first attempt. 100% (1 of 1) successfully passed Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination on second attempt.

Positive Placement: 100% (5 out of 5) students of the 2016 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.
