



Paramedic Program

The Paramedic program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on 23 March 2015.

In accordance with CAAHEP Standard V.A.4., The program will publish, preferably in a readily accessible place on their websites, the 3-year review-window average results of the outcomes for: National Registry (or State, as applicable) Written and Practical Exams, Retention, and Positive Placement.

All paramedic classes graduate in December.

Pre-Accreditation 3 year review window average results for 2016, 2015, and 2014:

National Registry examination: 3 year average – 79% (31 out of 39)

2016: 13 out of 15 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (86%)

2015: 6 out of 10 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (60%)

2014: 12 out of 14 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (86%)

Retention: 3 year average – 77% (40 out of 52)

2016: 17 Students registered. 16 graduated from the program for a retention rate of 94%

2015: 16 Students registered. 10 graduated from the program for a retention rate of 63%

2014: 19 students registered. 14 graduated from the program for a retention rate of 74%

Positive Placement: 3 year average – 100% (40 out of 40)

2016: All students were employed in field. (16 out of 16)

2015: All students were employed in field. (10 out of 10)

2014: All students were employed in field. (14 out of 14)
