



Paramedic Program

The Paramedic program at Central Georgia Technical College received continuing CAAHEP accreditation on 16 January 2020.

In accordance with CAAHEP Standard V.A.4., The program will publish, preferably in a readily accessible place on their websites, the 3-year review-window average results of the outcomes for: National Registry (or State, as applicable) Written and Practical Exams, Retention, and Positive Placement.

All paramedic classes for 2016 and 2017 graduated in December. For 2018 the classes graduated in May and December.

3 year review window average results for 2018, 2017, and 2016:

National Registry examination:

2018: 12 out of 15 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (80%)

2017: 8 out of 11 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (73%)

2016: 13 out of 15 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (86%)

Retention:

2018: 17 students registered. 15 completed the program for a retention rate of 89%

2017: 19 students registered. 11 completed the program for a retention rate of 58%

2016: 17 Students registered. 16 completed the program for a retention rate of 94%

Positive Placement:

2018: All students were employed in the field. (15 out of 15)

2017: All students were employed in the field. (11 out of 11)

2016: All students were employed in the field. (16 out of 16)
