How to Pay for Tuition and Fees

Students can pay for tuition and fees:

1. In person at the cashier window on the Warner Robins (A-129), Macon (J-152), or Milledgeville (A-141) Campus we accept the following types of payment: cash, check, money order, and credit/debit card (Visa and MasterCard))
2. Online, using BannerWeb, with a credit/debit card or check
3. Titans FlexPay automatic payment plan*
4. Third party (employer, public agency, or support program)**

Automatic Payment Plan*

This is not a loan program; there are no interest or finance charges, and there is no credit check. For a non-refundable enrollment fee (per semester), Nelnet will pay your tuition and fees and provide you with a monthly payment plan:

Third Party**

3. Lists all charges (tuition and/or fees) that the employer/agency intends to pay
4. Is submitted to CGTC's Business Office before the payment deadline
