

Dual Enrollment Option B

Carpentry



High School Graduation Option B offers qualified students an alternate path to high school graduation. Students choose to simultaneously earn a high school diploma and a college Associate Degree, or a Technical Diploma, or two (2) Technical Certificates of Credit in a specific career pathway. The dual enrollment funding program cap of 30 credit hours applies.

Complete all required high school courses:

- 2 English: American Literature & Another
- 2 Math: Algebra 1 or Coordinate Algebra & Another
- 2 Science: Biology & Another
- 2 Social Studies: *beginning with freshman class
- 2022-23, students will be required to take Personal Finance, Economics & American Government
- 1 Health/PE
- All required Milestone/EOC Exams

Complete any of the following Technical College Credentials:

- Any one Associate Degree
- Any one Diploma Program
- Two TCCs from approved list



High School Graduation Option B: Carpentry - Two Technical Certificate of Credit Option

Technical Certificates: *CF21 and AB71

Locations: Macon

Entry Points: Fall, Spring, and Summer

Total Semesters Needed: 4

Total Credit Hours: 31 credit hours for certificates. Dual enrollment funding can cover 30 credit hours. The remaining 1 credit hour can be covered by HOPE/Hope Career Grant *residency requirements & separate application applies, or a student can choose to self-pay.
