



CENTRAL GEORGIA TECHNICAL COLLEGE and TRINITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Purpose and Goals

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) formally recognizes that Central Georgia Technical College (CGTC) and Trinity School of Medicine (Trinity) are active partners in providing educational opportunities for currently enrolled and prospective students of both institutions. This agreement is intended to develop an infrastructure that will sustain the capacity of the two institutions to promote educational opportunities and to foster a lasting community partnership.

Agreement Provisions

This agreement is an umbrella agreement between these two institutions of higher education. It is intended to assist the member institutions to initiate efforts to improve the quality and availability of post-secondary educational opportunities.

Recognizing that educational opportunities can be enhanced by combining resources, both institutions agree to share resources, to the extent practical, to enhance opportunities to provide education and training that leads to employment in the health profession. The institutions further agree to consider articulation agreements to facilitate transition of students in specified health science programs between Central Georgia Technical College and Trinity School of Medicine. These agreements are intended to eliminate duplication of courses, promote advanced placement into baccalaureate-level programs at Trinity, and to provide a framework for degree completion, consistent with the mission, goals and objectives of both institutions.

All policies and procedures related to both institutions and their respective accrediting agencies will be applicable to this agreement.

Signatures

This agreement is in effect and valid starting with the date of the signatures of both Presidents and will remain in effect until terminated in writing by either institution.
