The four key steps in first aid for children and infants: prevent, protect, assess, and act

The assessment and first aid actions for the following life-threatening conditions: difficulty breathing, choking, severe bleeding, and shock

Control bleeding and bandage wounds

Correctly remove protective gloves

Use an epinephrine pen

Recognize elements of common injuries and illnesses

High-quality CPR for an infant and child

The concepts of the Chain of Survival

Give effective breaths by using mouth-to-mouth or a mask for all age groups

Demonstrate how to use an AED on a child

When and how to help a choking infant and child
