

# OSHA 30 Hour for General Industry



The OSHA 30 Hour for General Industry class provides workers with some safety responsibility in a greater depth and variety of training compared to the 10-hour version. All outreach training is intended to cover an overview of the hazards a worker may encounter on a job site. Training emphasizes hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention, not OSHA standards.

This OSHA 30 hour General Industry course is delivered over five days by an OSHA Authorized Trainer.
