

Students are responsible for paying all tuition and fees by the first day of the semester/mini-mester:
 Full semester and mini-mester session 1 classes: **August 15, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.**
 Mini-mester session 2 classes: **October 11, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.**

How to Pay for Tuition and Fees

Students can pay for tuition and fees:

1. In person at the cashier window on the Warner Robins (A-129), Macon (J-152), or Milledgeville (A-141) Campus (we accept the following types of payment: cash, check, money order, and credit/debit card (Visa and MasterCard))
2. Online, using BannerWeb, with a credit/debit card or check
3. By phone at (478) 757-3412 or (478) 218-3387 using a credit/debit card
4. Financial aid* and/or scholarship
5. Titans FlexPay automatic payment plan**
6. Third party (employer, public agency, or support program)***

Financial Aid*


If you plan to pay for tuition and fees using financial aid, you must complete these steps **FIRST** to find out if you are eligible to receive financial aid (*any delay in completing these steps will affect your financial aid!*):

1. Complete the FAFSA application at www.fafsa.ed.gov (CGTC's school code is **005763**) and submit all required documents
2. Wait for the Financial Aid Office to determine if you are eligible to receive aid
3. Check your postal mail or BannerWeb for information on your award status from CGTC
4. View and accept your financial aid award:
 1. Go to <https://bannerweb.centralgatech.edu> and click **Enter BannerWeb**
 2. Enter your **User ID** (your CGTC student ID number) and your **PIN** (your date of birth in MMDDYY format, unless you have changed it to something else), then click the **Login** button.
 3. Click **Student Services**
 4. Click **Financial Aid**
 5. Click **My Award Information**
 6. Click **Award By Aid Year**, select **July 1, 2018 - June 30, 2019**, then click the **Submit** button
 7. Carefully read the information on the **General Information**, **Award Overview**, and **Resources/Additional Information** tabs.
 8. Click the **Terms and Conditions** tab, then accept the terms and conditions
 9. Click the **Accept Award Offer** tab, then accept or decline the award that is offered.

If you are accepting student loans for the first time, you must complete entrance counseling and a master promissory note at www.studentloans.gov. Failure to complete this step will prevent the disbursement of your student loan.

Automatic Payment Plan**

This is not a loan program; there are no interest or finance charges, and there is no credit check. For a non-refundable enrollment fee (per semester), Nelnet will pay your tuition and fees and provide you with a monthly payment plan:

[^]Tuition is due by the first day of the semester and/or mini-mester. Extended payment plan dates are provided only for students with extenuating circumstances and must be approved by the Business Office.

Payments to Nelnet may be made by a direct transfer from your bank account or by credit/debit card. The down payment (if needed) and enrollment fee will be processed immediately upon signing up, and monthly payments will be processed automatically by Nelnet on the 5th of each month. Third Party***

If your employer or other agency will pay your tuition and fees for you, please submit a letter from the employer/agency on employer/agency letterhead that:

1. Identifies a contact person at the employer/agency that will be responsible for issuing payment
2. Includes the billing address for the employer/agency
3. Lists all charges (tuition and/or fees) that the employer/agency intends to pay
4. Is submitted to CGTC's Business Office before the payment deadline

Federal Pell Grant
