## Mission Focused: The CGTC Academy Gains Accredited Status from Cognia

On June 17, 2022, the President's Office and the IE Division received notification that the College had successfully submitted a case for readiness on the status of our secondary program pathways under the CGTC Academy and is now an accredited high school through NCA CASI, NWAC, and SACS CASI.

The [CGTC Academy](#) offers two alternatives to a traditional high school diploma. The [Dual Achievement Program Pathway \(DAP\)](#) offers high school coursework for individuals aged 16 – 21. The [Career Plus High School Equivalency Pathway \(CPH\)](#) offers high school coursework for individuals aged 21 and over. Both Pathways include the opportunity for enrolled students to take high school courses and credit level coursework towards a minimum of two technical certificates of credit leading to an accredited high school diploma and college level credential for quick entry into the workforce.

- ⇒ Automotive Technology, Houston County Career Academy – Successfully received ASE accreditation renewal on January 20, 2022.
- ⇒ Associate of Science in Nursing – Received approval from ACEN on February 4, 2022, to offer the RN program on the Milledgeville campus effective August 2022.
- ⇒ Physical Therapist Assistant – Received continued accreditation status from CAPTE on April 26, 2022, after submission of the follow-up compliance report.

## CGTC Successfully Conducts Perkins V Internal Control Review: No Findings

CGTC hosted a successful Perkins Grant Internal Controls Review on May 19, 2022. The Perkins Review Team assessed CGTC's compliance with regulations associated with the expenditure of federal Perkins funds over a three-year period. The review included a thorough compliance audit of equipment,

approved budgeted activities and personnel, and a review of the level of involvement by grant prescribed stakeholders. CGTC is pleased to report that the reviewers found that the College was in compliance with all requirements. In other words, the review team concluded that CGTC expended allocated federal Perkins funds in a manner consistent with

applicable regulations, standards and other associated regulations. The IE Office thanks everyone involved in the Perkins review process and for the continued commitment to Perkins grant activities, requirements, and processes.

## Grant Highlight

### Project CAFÉ (CGTC Action for Equity) – Predominantly Black Institutions (PBI) – Discretionary Grant

Project CAFÉ supports increasing postsecondary access, persistence, and completion for African American male students in STEM and Health Education programs through the creation of equitable, inclusive learning environments for diverse student populations over a five year project period (Oct 2021 – Sep 2026).

**Project Activities:**

- Increase access to accelerated occupational training in high demand STEM and Health fields;
- Provide underserved students with academic support services that contribute to improved learning outcomes;
- Embed faculty-developed digital learning resources into STEM and Health education courses;
- Provide underserved students with expanded social supports;

- Deliver professional development in the areas of
  - 1) creating digital resources that enhance remote learning and
  - 2) diversity, equity, and inclusion.

**Outcomes:**

- ⇒ Establishing baseline data in Year 1 (mid-year results)
- ⇒ Enrollment (African American males): 730
- ⇒ Persistence (Fall to Spring) Rate: 59% (326 / 551)
- ⇒ Completion/Transfer Rate: 21% (113 / 551)

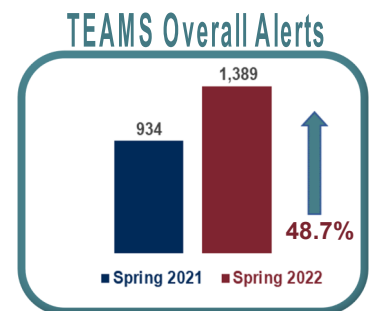
