GLOBAL INITIATIVES



In 2018, CGTC completed a three-year USAID contract with the University of Massachusetts to design and implement a two-year IT associate degree at Afghanistan's Kabul Polytechnic University.

Two cohorts of students have successfully graduated from this program.

For the third year, a CGTC student received the Benjamin A. Gilman scholarship, a national award for study abroad students.

GEORGIA VECTR CENTER



The Georgia VECTR Center served 12,311 veterans and awarded 136 credentials to veterans and/or their dependents. VECTR provided a total of 18,867 unique services to veterans and their dependents.

RE-ENTRY SERVICES



CGTC awarded 792 technical certificates of credit and 2,649 On-the-Job Training (OJT) Program awards to Georgia Department of Corrections (GDC) re-entry and pre-release students.

The RESET Scholarship was awarded to a currently enrolled CGTC student who was previously incarcerated in a Georgia Department of Corrections supervised facility.
